Ordinance No. 774

An Ordinance Amending Chapter 8.08 Storage, Disposal, and Collection of Refuse of the Lowden Municipal Code

Be It Enacted by the Council of the City of Lowden, Iowa:

I. Chapter 8.08 Storage, Disposal, and Collection of Refuse of the Lowden Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

- 1. Add - **Section 8.08.230 – Burning.**
 - a. It shall be unlawful for any person to burn or incinerate any solid waste within the City. This Section shall apply to all solid waste as defined by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources and shall specifically include all wastepaper, boxes, building materials, yard waste, tree stumps, and all other materials other than conventional materials used as fuels for a furnace or boiler.
 - b. This Section shall not apply to any incinerator operated under a license granted by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources nor to any burning conducted under the direction of the Fire Department for training purposes.
 - c. This Section shall not apply to outdoor cooking or a campfire whereby the fire must be no larger than two (2) feet in diameter.

2. Add - **Section 8.08.240 – Enforcement**
 Initial violators of this code will first be given a written warning about the regulations and asked to cease any open burning immediately. Any subsequent violation hereof shall be deemed to be a municipal infraction and shall be subject to a \$100 fine.

II . When Effective: This Amendment to Chapter 8.08 of the Lowden Municipal Code shall be in effect after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
