ORDINANCE NO. 778

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", CHAPTER 12 "PARKING" OF THE LOWDEN, IOWA CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING TITLE 10, SECTION 12.040(D) TO DELETE A REFERENCE TO TRUCK PARKING AND BY ADDING A NEW TITLE 10, SECTION 12.041 "TRUCK PARKING PROHIBITED"

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lowden, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. Title 10, Section 12.040 is hereby deleted and a new Title 10, Section 12.040 is included as follows:

10.12.040 Stopping, Standing or Parking Prohibited. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control device, in any of the following places:

A. In any public alley within the corporate city limits of the City. (Ord. 751, 05-07-01).

B. In any private alley within the corporate city limits of the City, in such a manner that ingress or egress of fire apparatus to or from such alley is blocked. (Ord. 751, 05-07-01).

C. Upon any street within the corporate city limits when snow or ice removal is necessary. (Ord. 751, 05-07-01: (§2 (part) of Ord. dated 8-2-82).

SECTION 2. Purpose. A new Section 10.12.041, in the Lowden Code of Ordinances, entitled "Truck Parking Prohibited" is hereby created as follows:

10.12.041 Truck Parking Prohibited. The parking of vehicles with a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) 13,500 lbs. or more is prohibited except in specific areas as designated by resolution adopted by the City Council. This specifically includes, but is not limited to, vehicles described as "semi-trucks" including the tractor and trailer, either attached or separate.


SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Severability clause. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. When Effective. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon posting as required by Iowa law.


